Again, welcome back for the 2017-2018 school year! Mrs. A. Coletto, Principal



SCHOOL BELL TIMES

We are on a BALANCED DAY timetable at St. Brigid Catholic Elementary School. This means that we have 2 40-minute breaks each day. Students will go outside for the first 20 minutes and then will return inside to eat for the remaining 20 minutes twice a day.

VOLUNTEERS Provincial law makes it mandatory that volunteers who work with children must have a current police check. For those volunteers that have provided a police check in the past must sign a declaration form each year. More information about the process can be obtained at the office. ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

As you know the safety of the children under our care is one of our most important responsibilities.

To help us keep the students safe and to help us keep track of all the students under our care the following policies will continue to be followed this year:

- 1) If your child is going to be absent please call Safe Arrival to report the absence. Students may not leave the school unless they have a note from their parents and they are picked up by an adult at the office. The adult must come into the school and sign the student out.
- 2) All students should be in the playground by 8:45a.m. and should be lining up with their class for entry. Any student that is late must report to the office for a late slip.
- 3) A child who is going out for lunch is to be picked up by an adult at the office so they can be signed out. Students may not leave school property without prior permission.
- 4) All visitors to the school are asked to report to the main office and sign in the visitor's book. If someone other than a parent is meeting your child, kindly let the teacher know.

VISITING THE SCHOOL:

Parents, grandparents, guardians and visitors to our school are reminded to please use the main doors to enter the building during school hours and to come directly to the office to sign in. If you are picking up your child for an appointment, your child will be called down to the office with his/her belongings to meet you.

To keep our school safe for all students and staff we ask that parents/guardians do not visit classrooms during class time without an appointment. If you need to speak to your child's teacher please make an appointment for a time that is convenient for both you and the teacher. Communication between the school and home is vital for success and we definitely want to support your child's education at all times—we kindly request that you please use the agenda or phone the school to set up meeting times as it is difficult for classroom teachers to meet with parents without a prior set appointment.

If you would like to speak with the principal please call the school to set up a time as it is sometimes difficult to meet during the day depending on what is happening in the school. We look forward to getting to know all of our families over the upcoming year and appreciate your support.

MEDICAL /ALLERGY CONCERNS

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board has procedures that must be followed for the proper dispensing of medication. In order to help us at the school, if your child requires medication of any kind, please have your child come to the office or send a note to the teacher to get the forms that must be completed. We ask that parents send the medication clearly labeled with your child's name. All medications must be delivered to the office with the proper documentation. Please help keep our school a safe learning environment for all.

Non-prescription medication requires the parent's signature on the Administration of Medication Form. Forms are available in the school office. We cannot dispense or supervise the intake of medication at school without written authorization.

There are a number of students in our school who are allergic to and in some cases have anaphylactic reactions, to peanut butter, tree nuts, sesame seeds/oil and/or peanut food products and pineapple. These reactions can be caused by ingestion and/or airborne. We ask for your assistance by not sending any snacks or lunches that contain NUT/PEANUT products. We also ask you to remind your children not to share snacks, treats or lunches at any time with others. For a list of snacks please visit www.anaphylaxis.canada.ca

We are asking the students to please bring in products that are allergen aware. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Please remember that we are attempting to make this school an allergen aware environment to ensure the safety of our students. INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGES

The H.W.C.D.S.B. offers free language classes to all students presently enrolled in an elementary school in Ontario. The focus of the Elementary Program is to offer children an opportunity to develop and/or maintain the ability to listen, speak and write a new language or the language of the home or heritage, and at the same time learn about the culture and heritage associated with the language. Classes take place 2.5 hours per week and no prior knowledge of the language is necessary. Registration will be held on the week of September 9th to 15th. However, students are eligible to register for a class at any time throughout the school year. Languages offered and their sites are listed below. 
