

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

As the newsletter is being created for the month of March, the sun is shining and the air is so warm, it truly feels like spring even though we are just about to begin March. It is hard to believe that we are more than half way through the school year. It continues to be a wonderful blessing to be a part of this great school community.

We are in the midst of Lent and during this season our Grade 2 students will be making their First Reconciliation, the first of two sacraments they will receive this year. It is so fitting that this sacrament takes place during the season of Lent. Thank you to our teachers, Father Jarek and parents who are preparing our students for this exciting time of their young lives.

In Pope Francis' 2018 Lenten address he stated: "I urge the members of the Church to take up the Lenten journey with enthusiasm, sustained by almsgiving, fasting and prayer. If, at times, the flame of charity seems to die in our own hearts, know that this is never the case in the heart of God! He constantly gives us a chance to begin loving anew. One such moment of grace will be, again this year, the "24 Hours for the Lord" initiative, which invites the entire Church community to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation in the context of Eucharistic adoration. In 2018, inspired by the words of Psalm 130:4, "With you is forgiveness", this will take place from Friday, 9 March to Saturday, 10 March. In each diocese, at least one church will remain open for twenty-four consecutive hours, offering an opportunity for both Eucharistic adoration and sacramental confession." We are all encouraged to take part in the sacrament of Reconciliation: to create a deeper connection to God and our faith.
